- To determine the “price point”, the lowest evaluated price bid (X) will automatically score maximum 100 points. All other price bids receive points in inverse proportion according to the following formula:
 - **Pt = 100(X/Z)**
 - Where:
 - Pt = Price points for the **Price Bid** being evaluated
 - 100 = maximum number of points for the **Lowest Evaluated Price Bid**
 - X = price of the **Lowest Evaluated Priced Bid**
 - Z = price of the **Bid Being Evaluated**
- The Employer shall determine the Most Advantageous Bid. 16. O candidato deverá apresentar justificação - na proposta financeira - caso o preço proposto não atinja **70%** da estimativa de custo (preço anormalmente baixo).
17. O Contratante deverá adjudicar o contrato ao Concorrente com a pontuação global mais elevada, avaliada de acordo com o procedimento especificado na Secção 3 – Procedimento de Avaliação de Propostas - desde que o Concorrente seja declarado como qualificado para a execução do Contrato de forma satisfatória.
