Development of commercial center is also in line with IX Government Constitutional Program, whereas, the Government will build shopping center that will support regional development zones, in accordance with the National Planning Framework. 2. Funding for these Services will be made from “the Infrastructure Fund of the Government of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste”.
3. The Project is located in Taibessi, Dili.
